



1.0 Ubanvpn OpenVPN Connect Windows 7 Installation Guide

1.1 Launch an Internet Explorer or default Internet Browser session


1.2 Enter the address <https://gw.ubanvpn.com> and press return




1.3 Enter your assigned credentials in the username and password fields then click on Go :

1.6 Click on Run






1.9 Click on Continue




1.10 Enter your password and click Connect




1.11 An OpenVPN – Warning Window appears: Click “YES”




1.12 Information Pop-up window appears “gw.ubanvpn.com connected”:
